Re: Home Learning and Updates

I am writing to inform you of arrangements for home learning whilst your child is unable to attend school as well as some other important updates.

Home Learning

Tuesday 5th January

Pupils will follow their usual timetable. The majority of this offer will take place using the Nando's worksheets that are now available to view on at the following link: <https://www.southallschool.com/nandos-home-work-sheets/> . For those who do not have access to the internet to download the Nando's sheet, these will be distributed to you as soon as possible.

For pupils who would ordinarily have English and Maths lessons, these will in most cases take place online via Teams sessions. You will receive invites for these before the session. A timetable for tomorrow will be published on the school website before 9am, this will show each lesson that pupils will need to complete.

Wednesday 6th – Friday 8th January

Pupils will be accessing a curriculum comprising their usual subjects, taking place via Teams, Purple Mash and / or Nando's worksheets. We are still ironing out the finer details of this and will communicate the timetable for the rest of the week by the end of the day tomorrow.

Home Learning Consent and Support

If you are yet to give your consent to allow your child to take part in remote learning, please contact the school to do so as soon as possible. The link to the Google Form will be re-sent in the morning to allow you to complete it digitally if you haven't already done so and still wish to.
